All participating firms must submit their bids strictly adhering to the revised engineering scope detailed below, which replaces the initial generic items:

	<p>1. Earth Electrode for earthing shall comprise of 25mm X 3040mm X 6 mm thick copper plate with 4 Nos. 6mm dia brass nuts, bolts and washers 70 sqmm HDHC copper Wire as earthing leads.</p> <p>2. A 100 mm dia Medium Duty GI Pipe shall be used with 10mm dia holes @ 500 mm C-C. the total length of this GI Pipe should be 45 Feet.</p> <p>3. A 150 mm dia 60 ft long hole should be drilled in the ground and above mentioned 100mm dia medium duty GI Pipe should be fixed in this hole simultaneously up to the depth of 60 ft from NSL.</p> <p>4. ## 2. Proceedings


The meeting was called at 11:00 AM to brief potential bidders on the project requirements, specifications, and terms and conditions. Since no prospective bidders appeared for the session, the committee formally reviewed the tender requirements internally alongside the technical inputs proposed by the Director Works.

To ensure optimal structural safety and alignment with engineering standards, the internal committee incorporated revised, comprehensive specifications proposed by the Director Works. These updated guidelines supersede the preliminary schedule and shall become an official part of the evaluation criteria for the technical and financial proposals.

## 3. Revised Eligibility & Mandatory Requirements

In addition to the baseline requirements outlined in the bidding documents, the committee clarified that the following mandatory technical qualifications must be fulfilled by participating firms:

- **PEC License:** Must be valid till date.
- **PEC Category:** C-6 (or higher).
- **Electrical Code:** EE-04 (Electrical Engineering Specialization).
- **Experience:** Firms must have successfully completed at least two (2) relevant projects in Government, Semi-Government, or Autonomous organizations.
- **Tax Registration:** Bidders must be registered with the Income Tax and Sales Tax Departments and appear on the FBR Active Taxpayers List (ATL).



## 5. Important Clarifications & Reminders






Bidders are directed to carefully review the original bidding standard documents alongside these modifications:

- **Pricing:** Cost proposals must be inclusive of all applicable Federal/Provincial taxes, factors, and duties on an F.O.R. basis. All prices must remain valid for at least 120 days from the tender opening date.
- **Submission Details:** Original physical copies of the 2% Earnest Money (CDR) and the Rs. 4,000/- Tender Processing Fee receipt must arrive at the Treasurer's office prior to the closing deadline.
- **E-Bidding Requirement:** Electronic bids must be successfully uploaded via the EPADS platform before **10:30 AM on Thursday, June 18, 2026**. Technical and financial bids will be opened on the same day at 11:00 AM.

## 6. Adjournment

The meeting concluded with a formal decision to publish these minutes online and integrate them directly into the bidding criteria for transparency.
